### DISC GOLF UPDATE

Barbara stated that the City Council approved the disc golf proposal on November 13, 2018 and Zac has ordered the equipment and will be installing the course. Councilmember T.J. Mitchell said he played the Ogden course and was very happy to approve the idea for Clinton. Mr. Cluff said that once the goals are put in, then signs will be installed and any other concerns will be addressed.

### BOARD APPOINTMENTS

Angela said that she and Darryl would be dropping off the board effective immediately due to other outside projects taking so much of their time. The Board instructed the Secretary to put a notice in the City's newsletter, and to also check with Kent Drayer, who had previously submitted an application, and with Jason McKaughan since he was so instrumental in getting the disc golf project completed.

### 2019 PLANS

- a) Mr. Cluff said that a bathroom has been approved for the west side of the cemetery, in conjunction with the trail. Barbara said that a citizen has inquired about putting a directory in the cemetery as well. Also, the columbarium is being worked on. Mr. Cluff and the Mayor need to review the location and get the ordinances in place. It also needs to be determined if it will be one side or two sided, but a bench will be installed. Also, Zac would like the plaques on the the burial niches to be all uniform.
- b) Pickle ball courts – An application for a grant is planned for February and if approved, work can be done by the end of the year. If the grant is not approved, then the City Council will have to decide where the money will come from.
- c) There is an Eagle Scout project planned for Heritage Park for orienteering.

- d) A bathroom is planned for the east end of Pond Park, with an adjacent parking area. Mr. Cluff pointed out that all restrooms are locked for the winter, but a Port-a-Potty has been installed at the family camp area in the Civic Center Park.
- e) The city will need to look at updating the plan for the area on 1300 North and to incorporate the detention basin acreage.
- f) Mr. Cluff said that other park improvements will be made in the next few months and he will report back to the Board.
- g) Heritage Days – Barbara will notify the committee that the Board will have a booth again this year. Perhaps Jason or someone can provide a demonstration of the disc golf at our booth. Mr. Cluff said that the Recreation Department is setting up classes to teach disc golf.
