BOARD APPLICANTS

Jason McKaughan appeared and briefed the Board on his background and interests. Mr. Cluff said that Kent Draayer had also re-submitted his application, but was not present for this meeting. The Board recommended to the Mayor that Jason McKaughan and Kent Draayer be appointed to the 2 vacancies on the Parks Advisory Board. Mr. Cluff said he would put this on next Tuesday's (February 26, 2019) meeting of the City Council.

VETERAN'S PARK

Mr. Cluff said that the city has been looking for a masonry contractor and now has one scheduled to do the concrete work. A sidewalk will be installed from the parking lot running south, along the east side of the bowery, all the way to the restroom. Parks money will be used for this. A concrete base for masonry blocks will be installed to hold the commemorative bricks. The design will fan out from the rock like wings. The Board expressed interest that this could be completed by Memorial Day and we can advertise it at our Heritage Days booth.

MISCELLANEOUS & NEWSLETTER

Miscellaneous - Mr. Cluff said that a grant will be prepared for May 1<sup>st</sup> for money for the pickle ball courts at Meadows Park. That, along with the cash donation received last year, should pay for the project. It will renovate the old tennis court area, replacing the base, and perhaps install lights. There will be 8 courts.

He also said that the City has reached an agreement with Rocky Mountain Power regarding Powerline Park. We now have a perpetual easement and won't have to pay rent any more. Barbara said that the Heritage Days Golf Tourney will be at Cranefield and the Parks Board will have a booth at Heritage Days.
