REVIEW MINUTES

Bev reviewed the minutes from the May 1, 2024 meeting. Minutes accepted as read.

HERITAGE DAYS

The Board members reviewed the 2 days of participation. Survey showed many people want more playground equipment, restroom facilities, trail improvements, a senior center, a dog park, and more trees. Brooke said that Clinton's Heritage Days was the biggest compared to surrounding area and even bigger than the Weber County Fair.

REORGANIZATION

Ordinance 24-04 establishes the new RAP Tax Committee. Jason reviewed this for Kent. As soon as the Ordinance is passed, there will no longer be a separate Parks Advisory Board or an Arts Board. Any members of that Board can apply to be on the new RAP Tax Committee. The Mayor will review the applications and choose who will be on the new Committee. The term will be 2 years. Because this was a surprise to our Board members (four of which appeared at the last City Council meeting) the Ordinance was tabled until the next Council meeting on August 27th. The Parks Advisory Board will be eliminated but may serve as a subcommittee to the new RAP Tax Committee. The new committee would direct how the old boards will handle Heritage Days, Fire Station Open House, etc. Once the ordinance is passed, the new Committee will start setting up their meetings, time, place, etc. It was suggested that the Mayor may want to reach out to the Arts Board to make sure they are aware of this change.

Brooke said that with this new RAP tax money, we'll be able to do extra things for the parks, recreation, arts, etc., in addition to the already budgeted amounts each year. It was suggested that when projects are done because of the RAP tax money, signs should be put up to show the public what their RAP tax money is doing.

PARCS BOARD

Bev reviewed this Board and its purpose to get donations, grants, etc. from organizations and people who generally donate to 501c3 entities.
