CANAL TRAIL

In review of last month's minutes, Mr. Cluff said that the city is looking at the contract agreement for the area between 2000 W and 3000 W. He said that horses could be allowed on the north side now, but the City Council decided a long time ago to not allow it. The County is maintaining the trail now. Mr. Cluff said that the trail may have to switch to the south side if the trail is extended west. He said that the man-gate is the city's responsibility; the other gates are the County's.

FIRE STATION OPEN HOUSE

We gave out a lot of maps; some people took adopt-a-park information; and people also took application forms for the Veteran's brick program. It was a very large turn-out. The generator located by the fire station is below ground level and a safety hazard. This was brought to the attention of Capt. Holly Nielson.

MISCELLANEOUS & NEWLETTER

- a) Veteran's Park – The flag is now installed, but the benches may not be yet.
- b) Meadows Park – Mr. Cluff said that we received the \$90,000 donation, along with a Land & Water Grant, which will be used for the pickle ball courts. Mr. Cluff said the city is looking at new toys, with ADA accessibility for the park. Rocky Mountain Power has donated \$5,000 towards those new toys. In addition, the toys at Meadows now will be moved to Kestrel, and the Kestrel toys will possibly be moved to the Pond Park. Mr. Cluff said that the parking lot at Meadows will also be renovated.
- c) Newsletter – Promote the adopt-a-park program in the November letter and for the December letter, promote the Veteran's bricks for Christmas gifts and we can make up a certificate that people can give as the present.
- d) Jason asked about the water pooling around the bowery in the Civic Center Park. He said the practice basket for the disc golf is usually damp. Mr. Cluff said he would have to check with Zac about the watering schedule and the amount of water used.
